



CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

- 1 **CHARLES MIGNON GRAND CRU 2012**
Flute (125ml) £9.50 Bottle £55
Its mellow gold hue is a sign of its ageing. A creamy mousse and extremely fine bubbles. The nose reveals elegant and balanced notes of white flowers, peaches, almonds and delicate mineral notes.
- 2 **BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV**
Flute (125ml) £11 Bottle £65
Instantly recognisable and a real favourite with our customers, this celebrated Champagne displays a wealth of toasty richness and tiny pin-prick bubbles - the hallmark of the very finest fizz.
- 5 **HAMBLEDON BRUT**
£80
This English fizz has notes of fresh sourdough, magnolia and lily scents mingle with a hint of smoke over a core of greengage, red plums and dessert apples. The Palate is vivid, almost vibrantly crunchy with precise, structured yet ripe acidity.
- 6 **BOLLINGER ROSÉ NV**
Flute (125ml) £13.50 Bottle £80
This rosé Champagne is packed with fresh strawberry, redcurrant, cherry and spice, backed up with a silky and fine texture.
- 8 **HAMBLEDON BRUT ROSÉ**
£99
This English fizz has beautiful, vivid wild-strawberry pink with a hue of red onion skin on the rim. On the nose, magnolia blossom is followed stridently by perfumed wild-strawberry compote with hints of buttered white sourdough toast. The palate is rich and mouth filling with flavours of strawberry balanced by zingy tart cranberry and pithy Amalfi lemon notes. The texture is creamy with a clean, crisp, yeasty finish.
- 9 **AYALA BLANC DE BLANC 2015**
£99
Notes of ripe citrus fruits, honey, dried fruit, and a very subtle touch of toast. The palate is extremely generous, structured and perfectly balanced despite the wine's relative youth, leading to a long, fresh and very pleasant finish. A very light and elegant cuvee which beautifully associates intense character and delicacy.
- 10 **BOLLINGER LA GRANDE ANNÉE 2014**
£185
Only produced in exceptional years from exclusively Grand Cru rated grapes. Rich, biscuity and yeasty, this wine carries the ultimate expression of the house style.
- 12 **KRUG VINTAGE**
£299
A truly elegant and very intense vintage Krug. This is a rich sumptuous and absolutely gorgeous vintage Champagne. It has a pale golden colour seductive white flower aromas and a full creamy and rich palate with flavours of grapefruit biscuit and hints of tropical fruits.
- 13 **CASTELNUOVO PROSECCO ROSÉ**
£35
Beautiful pink reminding of the colour of peach blossom and the rose. Intense, fruity complex and reminding the scent of flowers and fruits like peach, raspberry and ripe passion fruit.
- 14 **FOLLADOR PROSECCO DOCG**
Flute (125ml) £7 Bottle £38
Elegant nose with hints of apple, peach and rose petals. From a single vineyard called Torri di Credazzo, this is Prosecco at its best. Great with appetizers and shellfish pasta dishes.



DIRECTORS WHITE

- D1 LITTLE BEAUTY SAUVIGNON BLANC BLACK EDITION**
New Zealand. £90
Only the very best grapes from Little Beauty's finest parcels were used to produce this small production Sauvignon Blanc in 2016. Fermented with 100% wild yeast and aged on its lees in French oak to add both weight and depth, this aromatic wine displays herbal notes alongside flavours of tropical fruits and sandalwood aromas.
- D2 PAUL DELOUX CHABLIS**
France. £50
Is flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. Matured without oak.
- D3 GIVRY BRULEE BLANC 2017**
Bourgogne. £50
On the nose, it reveals intense and wild aromas of fresh fruit (blackcurrant, strawberry, redcurrant) and undergrowth. Supple and round on the palate, it is a well-balanced nectar that lacks neither vivacity nor finesse.
- D4 SANCERRE LANGLOIS CHATEAU**
France. £60
100% Sauvignon Blanc from Langlois-Chateau's best vineyards in the Sancerre AOC. This serious and complex Sancerre is a benchmark for the appellation, with brightness, intensity, depth and minerality.
- D5 BOUCHARD POUILLY FUISSE**
France. £85
A fine, pure wine, very fat. The nature of the "terroir" favours the harmonious development of the aromas of the grapes, with nuances of hazelnuts and grilled almonds. A rich, luscious wine.
- D6 OROPASSO BISCARDO**
Italy. £40
Biscardo Family is among the oldest wine family companies in Italy. After more than 140 years, each wine has a unique story: the soil, the vineyards, the ageing, not a single detail is missed to achieve Biscardo timeless quality.
- D7 VENTISQUERO GREY CHARDONNAY**
Chile. £55
Ventisquero Grey Glacier Chardonnay has a complex and elegant bouquet, in which the aromas of ripe tropical fruit, such as pineapple, mango and papaya intermingle with gentle mineral and citrus notes. The oak-ageing contributes gentle notes of vanilla and dried fruit. This well-structured wine is refreshing thanks to its crisp acidity, which provides a broad and persistent finish. The dried fruit and vanilla come through again in the aftertaste.
- D8 SAINT ROMAIN 2018 - BURGUNDY**
France. £95
A high quality white wine made with Chardonnay from the Côte de Beaune and aged in oak for 8-9 months. This wine is pale gold with green highlights. The nose presents a full range of limewood and white flowers. The flavours are beautiful with a nice minerality and a mellow, smooth finish.
- D9 BOURGOGNE HAUTES-COTES DE NUITS 2017**
Bourgogne. £50
Aromas of red summer berry fruit, wild strawberries, violets, red plums. Juicy, light tannins; silky texture.
- D10 DOMAINE BERTHELEMOT PULIGNY MONTRACHET - BURGUNDY**
France. £95
White flowers, ripe orchard fruit and gentle lemon citrus on the nose, and a beautifully linear palate with a brilliant mineral tension. The ripe fruit character builds as the wine warms in your mouth, seasoned with a cleverly balanced hint of oak. Seductive and long.

DIRECTORS RED

- D11 CHATEAU DU COURNEAU MARGAUX 2018**
Bordeaux. £45
Dark Bordeaux blend coming from a small family estate. Nice bouquet of mokka, blackberry, some cassis and also an earthy touch.
- D12 RESONANCE PINOT NOIR 2015**
USA. £60
The 2015 is sharp and peppery, with dark fruits, supple acids and hints of char and smoke. The tannins develop and benefit from decanting.
- D13 ORIN SWIFT 8 YEARS IN THE DESERT**
USA. £80
Seductive sweet fruit immediately bursts out of the glass, including luscious cassis, black cherry, and ripe dark plum. There are deeper undertones of forest floor, cedarwood, and gentle spice from the oak.
- D14 CHATAEU LES GRANDS CHENES MEDOC**
France. £70
A lot of dark berry flavour at its core, along with the classic shroomy, leathery taste that one can experience in many French style wines. Then it is accented with a light touch of vanilla. The earthy flavours remain in the palate for a long and pleasant finish. This wine demands — and deserves — an equally bold dish for dinner.
- D15 PAINTED WOLF PICTUS III**
South Africa. £70
An elegant, medium full-bodied wine combining charm with power, red berry and spice and a long, polished finish.
- D16 JEAN-LUC COLOMBO TERRES BRULÉES 2016**
Rhone. £70
Terres Brulées, or burnt earth, aptly describes the nose on this enticingly smoky, singed Syrah. Vinified from fully destemmed grapes and matured 21 months in oak.
- D17 PERRIN CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE 2016**
Rhone. £65
Profoundly ripe but pristine blackberry and plum are cutting and crisp in this full bodied but vibrant red. Deep mineral tones as well as firm, angular tannins contribute to its edgy style.
- D18 AMARONE LA COLOMBAIA VALPOLICELLA**
Italy. £95
This wine has been carefully produced from grapes which have been laid out to dry and become concentrated. The result is rich concentrated full-bodied with a long finish.
- D19 2012 CHÂTEAU LYNCH-BAGES, PAUILLAC**
Bordeaux. £240
The nose has dark fruits, cassis and licorice whilst the palate exudes rich, silky and sublime density, sweetness and glycerol. The expression and volume build in the mouth with freshness, focus and texture followed by a bright and lifting finish.
- D19 TOHU SINGLE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR**
New Zealand. £120
A deep crimson hue in the glass, this Awatere Valley Pinot Noir displays complex layers of cherry, plum and bright floral notes with underlying hints of wild thyme. The palate is richly concentrated with flavours of red and dark fruits, spice and integrated oak. Balanced with refined silky tannins, this complex and elegant wine seamlessly leads to a long, smooth and lingering finish.



WHITE WINES

- 15 **IL CAGGIO PINOT GRIGIO**
Italy. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26
This delicately refreshing dry white is lemon yellow colour. On the palate, flavours of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.
- 16 **VAUCLUSE IGP CHARDONNAY**
France. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26
Clear, intense and complex, the nose is carried by fruity aromas (pear, peach, plum), with almond and honey hints. The palate is fresh, broad and tasty, on ripe citrus notes, smoked butter and minerals.
- 17 **SOUTHERN LIGHTS SAUVIGNON BLANC**
New Zealand. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Classic Marlborough sauvignon, with the emphasis on vivid, lifted green fruit flavours rather than herbaceous ones. Pristine, racy and vibrant, with a lip-smacking, green-apple, lemon and lime palate.
- 18 **DUC DE MORNEY PICPOUL**
France. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Duc de Mornay Picpoul de Pinet is a fine, elegant and incredibly fruity Picpoul with a very long finish. Nicknamed 'la bomba' this is an ideal match for fish and shellfish.
- 19 **VALLEE BLANCHE VIOGNIER**
France. 175ml £7.50 250ml £9.50 Bottle £28
Sweet apple leads with dried apricot. Light citrus follows. Faint tropical mid notes. A well-rounded, velvet soft wine.
- 20 **PAINTED WOLF CHENIN BLANC**
South Africa. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Fruity white wine exploding with white peach, pear and honeydew melon. Hints of pineapple on the finish. The Den Chenin Blanc is a vibrant and juicy wine ideal for sharing with friends. Painted Wolf Wines supports the conservation of African wild dogs by donating 5% of UK revenue to the TUSK Foundation.
- 21 **FORTIUS BARREL AGED CHARDONNAY**
Spain. 175ml £8 250ml £11 Bottle £33
Golden in colour, complex on the nose with toasted character and ripe fruits. On the palate the wine is full bodied with good acidity and flavours of peach, roasted hazelnuts and honey, leading to a long balanced finish.
- 22 **GRANDE ARDECHE CHARDONNAY LOUIS LATOUR**
France. £47.50
Our Grand Ardèche has a brilliant straw-yellow hue. It reveals an intense nose with aromas of toast, vanilla and acacia flower. The mouth is round, powerful with a fresh almond finish. Nice persistence.
- 23 **CAPE MENTELLE SEMILLON SAUVIGNON 2017**
Margaret River. £50
Cape Mentelle is one of the 'Founding Five' wineries of Margaret River, one of Australia's finest wine regions. Its Sauvignon Blanc-Semillon is fresh and juicy, with creamy flavours of lemon and fresh herbs and a textured complexity, thanks to four months of lees ageing.
- 24 **PREMIERE THE LOIRE VOUVRAY**
France. £37
This pale straw coloured wine has a lush fruity bouquet with distinctive aromas of apricot, honey and grapefruit. The palate is medium sweet, honeyed with a mineral edge and concentrated, luscious apricot and pineapple fruit flavours with savoury undertones. All of which results in a delicious off dry wine, with a complex, lingering finish.
- 25 **WINZER KREMS GRÜNER VELTLINER 2020**
Austria. £32
Crisp, refreshing and the perfect accompaniment to Weiner Schnitzel this fine Gruner abounds in flavours of peach and citrus and finishes with notes of minerals and pepper.
- 26 **VILLA WOLF PINOT GRIS**
Australia. £40
Pinot Gris has a very long tradition in the Pfalz region. In fact, it was here that the variety was first identified. Villa Wolf Pinot Gris is made in a full-bodied, dry style with refreshing, unoaked fruit and a crackling texture.
- 26a **AQUARIUS VIOGNIER**
Australia. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £35
It delivers crisp stony freshness balanced by ripe peach with a dash of spice, all in the peace-loving spirit of Aquarius.

ROSÉ WINES

- 27 **MATRA HILL PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ**
Italy. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26
A delicate blend of soft summer fruits and light acidity combine to produce a gentle dry blush.
- 28 **WILDWOOD ZINFANDEL ROSÉ**
California. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26
A superb deep rich and full flavoured Rosé from the Lodi region of California. It is medium sweet, but not overly sweet, think tinned strawberries, this wine has the perfect balance of deep luscious strawberry and cherry flavours scents and flavours that leap from the glass and invite you back.
- 29 **JEAN-LUC COLOMBO ROSÉ**
Provence. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26
On the palate, notes of black olives, herbs and fresh fruit evoke the terroir of the Mediterranean coast. Made from a blend of Syrah, Cinsault and Mounvèdre from vineyards nestled in the hills above Marseille, the beautiful and aptly named Blue Coast in a glass.
- 30 **DOMAINES OTT BANDOL ROSÉ**
Provence. £70
Christian and Jean-François Ott, work with the iconic Champagne house, Louis Roeder, to craft this exceptional rosé. It's a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault that has elegant flavours of pink grapefruit, lemon and white flowers. It has a delicious minerality that's ideal with the saltiness of shellfish.
- 31 **PETITE ODETTE ROSÉ IGP**
France. £47
This beautifully elegant, dry rose has been sourced from specially selected vineyards in the sunny Mediterranean region. Pale pink in colour, it is packed with fresh strawberry and raspberry flavours.
- 32 **VISTAMAR CABERNET SYRAH ROSÉ**
Chile. £26
A bright pink colour with notes of blackcurrant, strawberry and raspberry. Refreshing on the palate.
- 33 **FEDELE ROSÉ ORGANIC**
Italy. £27
A highly characterful, bright rosé, with tons of fresh red berry fruit flavours - lively and vibrant.
- 33a **CAVALIER ROSÉ (1.5L)**
Provence. £65
The top wine in the Cavalier range, this is densely textured, with hints of minerality as well as fresh red fruits that convey extra richness and density.



RED WINES

- 34 **VAUCLUSE IGP SYRAH**
France. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26
A beautiful, vivacious, light red colour gives this natural red wine an elegant and attractive appearance. The nose has hints of strawberry and violet. The palate begins with light, soft tannins, leading into a long and fruity aftertaste with great purity and notes of pepper.
- 35 **LOS PASTOS CABERNET SAUVIGNON**
Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26
Smooth and easy drinking and packed with ripe blackcurrant flavour with a warming peppery finish. Aromas of blackberry, black cherry and plums, hints of vanilla with smooth rounded tannins.
- 36 **LOS PASTOS MERLOT**
Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26
Ideal for anyday casual drinking, it is a soft and fruity merlot with plenty of succulent berry and damson flavours. Also a pleasing hint of cinnamon spice typical of this user-friendly grape variety.
- 37 **VILLA MARIA PINOT NOIR 2017**
New Zealand. 175ml £7.25 250ml £9.25 Bottle £28
Subtle aromatics of dried herbs such as thyme and rosemary intermingled with blackberries and blackcurrants. On the palate, a toasty hint of oak nicely frames the firm but juicy fruit and fine velvety tannins.
- 38 **LEFT FIELD MALBEC**
New Zealand. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Left Field Malbec has very intense brooding characters of blackberry and liquorice together with the deep mass of dark chocolate draped in smooth, fine velvet on the palate.
- 39 **CAPITAN 'GAR' GARNACHA**
Spain. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30
A smooth Garnacha, showcasing cranberries, cherries and oak.
- 40 **PAINTED WOLF PINOTAGE**
South Africa. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Medium to full bodied with bright red and black summer berries, savoury spice, and toasty wood flavours - leading to a nicely poised finish.
- 41 **NEROPASSO ROSSO**
Italy. £32
After meticulous work in the vineyard to ensure even ripening, whole bunches are harvested by hand undergoing strict selection to allow a steady drying process before crushing and fermentation. The juice of the dried grapes gives the wine so much concentration and complexity. Spicy, velvet textured wine, with indulgent dried fruit and smooth tannin.
- 42 **U'PASSIMENTO**
Italy. £32
Made from partially dried grapes, this wine has bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. The palate is warm and full-bodied with sweet fruit, harmonious acidity, and smooth and elegant tannins.
- 43 **LOS VASCOS CABERNET SAUVIGNON**
Argentina. £32
Los Vascos Cabernet Sauvignon has a deep and intense ruby red colour. The nose features aromas of red fruit like plum, raspberry and cherry with savoury notes as well as tobacco, toasted hazelnuts, dark chocolate and tapenade. The mouth is dominated by the presence of young, lively tannins. Good concentration, nice structure and a persistent finish of great personality.
- 44 **RESONANCE PINOT NOIR 2018**
USA. £40
Just a hint of smoke and a touch of raspberry appear on the nose. That lovely raspberry note then carries over to the tender but textured palate where it meets riper cherry fruit. There is something sinuous about the fruit and the body of this slender but smooth wine, anchored firmly in fine, brisk tannin.
- 45 **PARINI MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO**
Italy. £35
Full-bodied red wine from Montepulciano grapes grown in the Abruzzo region. Deep color with raspberry notes, robust flavor, slightly tannic palate balanced with a smooth finish.
- 46 **BELLES LETTRES CAIRANNE SHIRAZ**
France. £45
On the nose this wine leads with marzipan and raisin with hints of vanilla. Caramel runs through with hint of aniseed taste and more vanilla.
- 47 **SUSUMANIELLO SALENT SERRE**
Italy. £50
A rich and smooth wine in the mouth, which reveals a vaguely sweet character with nuances in the scent of chocolate and autumn jams.
- 48 **LES COTEAUX COTES DU RHONE**
France. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30
Immediately impressive, this wine reveals its class from the start. Brambly fruit underpinned by subtle oaky nuances, lovely sweet spice - warm star anise with a touch of cinnamon.
- 49 **PORTIA ROBLE RIBERA DEL DUERO**
Spain. £42
Clean, bright, well covered, cherry, purple flashes. Nose: intense, dark fruit, blackberry and wood. Mouth: good structure, round tannins, good acidity and a good wood finish.
- 50 **HUSH HEATH PINOT NOIR**
United Kingdom. £70
Luke's Pinot Noir is one of England's finest red wines. Created only in exceptional vintages such as the marvellous 2018 and 2020, it is made from vineyards planted specifically for the still wine production.
