



## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

- 1 **MERCIER BRUT**  
*Flute (125ml) £9.50    Bottle £55*  
An assemblage of Pinot Noir Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay varieties - Brut Mercier has a straw yellow colouring. Its nose is dominated by seeded white fruits which blend with notes of freshly baked bread. The high proportion of Pinot grapes is expressed in a palate of ripe apple and pear aromas which climax in a delightfully fresh finish.
- 2 **MOËT & CHANDON IMPERIAL**  
*Flute (125ml) £11    Bottle £65*  
Flowery and fresh with notes of brioche and citrus, together with a clean persistent mousse.
- 3 **VEUVE CLICQUOT**  
*Flute (125ml) £10    Bottle £75*  
A famous Champagne for all the right reasons – a richer more flavoursome fizz with layers of baked apple fruit and a nice touch of cream on the finish.
- 4 **MOËT & CHANDON ICE**  
*Flute (125ml) £11    Bottle £75*  
Ice Impérial, the first and only champagne especially created to be enjoyed over ice. A new champagne experience combining fun, fresh and free sensations while remaining true to the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.
- 5 **RUINART**  
*Flute (125ml) £12    Bottle £80*  
Elegant and well-structured with a fine persistent mousse. Citrus fruit and nutty notes with hints of cream and a long dry finish. Ruinart is the earliest-established Champagne house.
- 6 **MOËT & CHANDON ROSE**  
*Flute (125ml) £13.50    Bottle £80*  
Lively and expressive dominated by the scent of wild strawberries. Full-bodied and zesty.
- 7 **MOËT & CHANDON GRAND VINTAGE**  
*£99*  
Bright, pale yellow with glints of green, and fine, persistent bubbles. Initial notes of fresh white flowers evolve towards sweet, fragrant pastries, with occasional scents of fresh walnuts, hazelnuts and biscuits. The fruit is crisp, freshly ripened, with aromas of pear, white peach and nectarine.
- 8 **RUINART ROSÉ**  
*£99*  
A fine-beaded Champagne with distinctive redcurrant aromas, leading to a fresh fruity palate, with well-balanced acidity.
- 9 **RUINART BLANC DE BLANC**  
*£99*  
Made from 100% chardonnay grapes, which produces a refined delicate Champagne with floral notes and a lingering creamy finish.
- 10 **DOM PERIGNON**  
*£185*  
The delicate aromas and flavours of Dom Perignon really develop in the glass when savoured slowly, as floral zesty notes give way to complex hazelnut brioche and cream.
- 11 **KRUG**  
*£210*  
A magnificent full-bodied Champagne fermented in oak barrels and blended from up to twenty different vintages for a decadently rich style. Enjoy!
- 12 **KRUG VINTAGE**  
*£299*  
A truly elegant and very intense vintage Krug. This is a rich sumptuous and absolutely gorgeous vintage Champagne. It has a pale golden colour seductive white flower aromas and a full creamy and rich palate with flavours of grapefruit biscuit and hints of tropical fruits.
- 13 **DI MARIA ROSATO SPUMANTE**  
*£35*  
Bright pink coral colour. Candied aromas and flavours of strawberry with a vibrant, effervescent, fruity light-to-medium body and a graceful, breezy finish. Accents of red licorice, anise, and peach sauce with soft, fruit tannins and no oak. A tasty and effortlessly drinkable sparkling rose for any occasion.
- 14 **DI MARIA PROSECCO**  
*Flute (125ml) £7    Bottle £38*  
Pale light yellow in colour with fine perlage. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. Well balanced and light body. Harmonic at the taste.



## DIRECTORS WHITE

### D1 LITTLE BEAUTY SAUVIGNON BLANC BLACK EDITION

*New Zealand. £90*

Only the very best grapes from Little Beauty's finest parcels were used to produce this small production Sauvignon Blanc in 2016. Fermented with 100% wild yeast and aged on its lees in French oak to add both weight and depth, this aromatic wine displays herbal notes alongside flavours of tropical fruits and sandalwood aromas.

### D2 PAUL DELOUX CHABLIS

*France. £50*

Is flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. Matured without oak.

### D3 MARIE LOUISE MACON VILLAGES BLANC

*France. £50*

Pale gold colour with green tints. A fresh straightforward bouquet blending notes of honeysuckle, fresh almonds and honey aromas. The immediate impression on the palate is lots of direct freshness and a mineral aspect that reveals itself at the finish.

### D4 SANCERRE LANGLOIS CHATEAU

*France. £60*

100% Sauvignon Blanc from Langlois-Chateau's best vineyards in the Sancerre AOC. This serious and complex Sancerre is a benchmark for the appellation, with brightness, intensity, depth and minerality.

### D5 DOMAINE LES VIEUX MURS

*France. £85*

An intense mineral and citrus character with strong hints of complex nutty, buttery flavours. Very well balanced with crisp acidity and good texture, this is a concentrated yet elegant wine..

### D6 LOROPASSO BISCARDO

*Italy. £40*

Biscardo Family is among the oldest wine family companies in Italy. After more than 140 years, each wine has a unique story: the soil, the vineyards, the ageing, not a single detail is missed to achieve Biscardo timeless quality.

### D7 VENTISQUERO GREY CHARDONNAY

*Chile. £55*

Ventisquero Grey Glacier Chardonnay has a complex and elegant bouquet, in which the aromas of ripe tropical fruit, such as pineapple, mango and papaya intermingle with gentle mineral and citrus notes. The oak-ageing contributes gentle notes of vanilla and dried fruit. This well-structured wine is refreshing thanks to its crisp acidity, which provides a broad and persistent finish. The dried fruit and vanilla come through again in the aftertaste.

### D8 SAINT ROMAIN 2018 - BURGUNDY

*France. £95*

A high quality white wine made with Chardonnay from the Côte de Beaune and aged in oak for 8-9 months. This wine is pale gold with green highlights. The nose presents a full range of limewood and white flowers. The flavours are beautiful with a nice minerality and a mellow, smooth finish.

### D9 GENETIE BOURGOGNE BLANC 'ILLUMINÉ' AOP - BURGUNDY

*France. £50*

A classic Chardonnay from Southern Burgundy - fine buttery and floral notes on the nose and a wine of substance and finesse on the palate. Some creamy textural notes up front reveal the discreet presence of oak, whilst on the finish there is some underlying minerality and a hint of citrus zestiness that provides long lasting flavours.

### D10 DOMAINE BERTHELEMOT PULIGNY MONTRACHET - BURGUNDY

*France. £95*

White flowers, ripe orchard fruit and gentle lemon citrus on the nose, and a beautifully linear palate with a brilliant mineral tension. The ripe fruit character builds as the wine warms in your mouth, seasoned with a cleverly balanced hint of oak. Seductive and long.

## DIRECTORS RED

### D11 CHATEAU LA TILERIE DU PUY BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR

*France. £45*

A Merlot dominant blend (60% Merlot/30% Cabernet Sauvignon / 10% Cabernet Franc).

### D12 THE CROSSINGS PINOT NOIR

*New Zealand. £50*

This expressive Pinot Noir has lifted fruit flavours in the dark berry spectrum balanced with earthy savory notes, vibrancy, purity and structure.

### D13 DARK SIDE OF THE MOON SHIRAZ

*Australia. £55*

A classic full bodied Clare Valley Shiraz; great structure with juicy, rich fruit.

### D14 BLACKBIRD SANGIOVESE

*Clare Valley, Australia. £55*

The 'Blackbird' is all about artisan, small batch winemaking. A wonderfully full flavoured and balanced, medium-weight bright ruby red wine. Elegant, velvety tannins fill the mouth. The aromatics are lifted and appealing; fresh cranberries with green olives and lots of Sangiovese light berry fruits.

### D15 PAINTED WOLF PICTUS III

*South Africa. £70*

An elegant, medium full-bodied wine combining charm with power, red berry and spice and a long, polished finish.

### D16 LES CALECHES DE LANESSAN HAUT MEDOC

*France. £70*

A savoury and complex nose leads to a vibrant and herbaceous palate.

### D17 2014 CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE CUVÉE PAPLE

*Rhone. £65*

Blended by Alex Favier, one of the region's best winemakers, this is an archetypal and rustic Châteauneuf-du-Pape, showing lovely ripe, spiced, black fruit aromas and a velvety, warm palate. Very correct, in a deliciously traditional style.

### D18 AMARONE LA COLOMBAIA VALPOLICELLA

*Italy. £95*

This wine has been carefully produced from grapes which have been laid out to dry and become concentrated. The result is rich concentrated full-bodied with a long finish.

### D19 CHATEAU PALAIS CARDINAL GRAND CRU ST EMILION

*Italy. £115*

Intense colour with spicy notes, aromatic finesse and tannins with good aging potential. The grapes are harvested by hand and the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels.

### D19 LITTLE BEAUTY PINOT NOIR BLACK EDITION

*New Zealand. £120*

Packed with aromas of raspberry, black cherry and red fruit alongside a hint of savoury notes, this Pinot Noir is truly one of a kind, with soft and silky tannins. Little Beauty is a privately-owned estate within Marlborough's Southern Valleys, where wines differ slightly from the mainstreams.



## WHITE WINES

- 15 **IL CAGGIO PINOT GRIGIO**  
*Italy. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26*  
This delicately refreshing dry white is lemon yellow colour. On the palate, flavours of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.
- 16 **LOS PASTO CHARDONNAY**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26*  
Inviting aromas of pear, pineapple and acacia flowers herald a fresh, medium bodied palate with notes of exotic fruit on the finish.
- 17 **SOUTHERN LIGHTS SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
*New Zealand. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Classic Marlborough sauvignon, with the emphasis on vivid, lifted green fruit flavours rather than herbaceous ones. Pristine, racy and vibrant, with a lip-smacking, green-apple, lemon and lime palate.
- 18 **DUC DE MORNEY PICPOUL**  
*France. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Duc de Morny Picpoul de Pinet is a fine, elegant and incredibly fruity Picpoul with a very long finish. Nicknamed 'la bomba' this is an ideal match for fish and shellfish.
- 19 **PETIT MAZUET VIOGINER**  
*France. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
The lush and aromatic Viognier displays with a shiny pale gold colour with green highlights towards the rim. A complex bouquet of apricot and peach, with notes of white flowers. Fruity, round and generous in mouth. Spicy and lively finish.
- 20 **PAINTED WOLF CHENIN BLANC**  
*South Africa. 175ml £7 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Fruity white wine exploding with white peach, pear and honeydew melon. Hints of pineapple on the finish. The Den Chenin Blanc is a vibrant and juicy wine ideal for sharing with friends. Painted Wolf Wines supports the conservation of African wild dogs by donating 5% of UK revenue to the TUSK Foundation.
- 21 **FORTIUS BARREL AGED CHARDONNAY**  
*Spain. 175ml £8 250ml £11 Bottle £33*  
Golden in colour, complex on the nose with toasted character and ripe fruits. On the palate the wine is full bodied with good acidity and flavours of peach, roasted hazlenuts and honey, leading to a long balanced finish.
- 22 **GRANDE ARDECHE CHARDONNAY LOUIS LATOUR**  
*France. £47.50*  
Our Grand Ardèche has a brilliant straw-yellow hue. It reveals an intense nose with aromas of toast, vanilla and acacia flower. The mouth is round, powerful with a fresh almond finish. Nice persistence.
- 23 **LITTLE BEAUTY SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
*New Zealand. £50*  
A myriad of Marlborough summer memories: reminiscent of mango, honey dew melon combine with lemon grass, red capsicum, mineral notes. An intriguing smokiness. Uplifting. Zesty, finishing juicy and mouth-watering. Flavours such as pink grapefruit, fresh basil, snow pea shoots and feijoa. Beautifully balanced.
- 24 **PREMIERE THE LOIRE VOUVRAY**  
*France. £37*  
This pale straw coloured wine has a lush fruity bouquet with distinctive aromas of apricot, honey and grapefruit. The palate is medium sweet, honeyed with a mineral edge and concentrated, luscious apricot and pineapple fruit flavours with savoury undertones. All of which results in a delicious off dry wine, with a complex, lingering finish.
- 25 **DR ZENDEN 1636 RIESLING**  
*Germany. £32*  
This Riesling is made in the classic Mosel style, a lovely balance between ripe fruit sweetness and zingy, racy, fresh acidity. The wine has been fermented to a finished alcohol of 11%, so it's slightly drier than typical Mosel Riesling which is usually 8.5%, but that makes this a better wine to drink with food as well as a lovely light, refreshing aperitif wine.
- 26 **MWC PINOT GRIS**  
*Australia.. £40*  
Sourced from premium grape growing regions in Victoria, this wine shows a slightly blush colour due to the juice having extended contact with the grape skins. This has produced a complex, textural and slightly savoury Pinot Gris with aromatic nuances of pears, lychees and exotic spice.

## ROSÉ WINES

- 27 **VITE VENTOSA PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ**  
*Italy. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
A delicate blend of soft summer fruits and light acidity combine to produce a gentle dry blush.
- 28 **SIERRA CREEK ZINFANDEL ROSÉ**  
*California. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
An easy drinking rose, full of strawberry & raspberry fruit aromas. Light bodied & refreshing, rich in flavours of red berry fruits.
- 29 **LOS PASTOS ROSÉ**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
It is a brilliant lively and clear wine, strawberry in colour. A complex nose of grapefruit, strawberries, granadilla, guava and peppery nasturtium excites ones senses. A dry lingering palate of pomegranate and berry fruits fills your mouth.
- 30 **KLEIN CONSTANCIA KC ROSÉ**  
*South Africa. £37.50*  
Bright and perfectly blush in appearance with aromas of fresh cherries and ripe citrus. The palate is light and refreshing complimented by a creamy texture and fresh acidity. The wine concludes with a crisp dry finish.
- 31 **AIX PROVENCE ROSÉ**  
*France. £47*  
Fragrant and well balanced, salmon pink in colour the nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers.
- 32 **PELUSAS CABERNET SYRAH ROSÉ**  
*Chile. £26*  
Concentrated cherry and raspberry fruit. A persistent lingering aftertaste and soft acidity makes this rosé extremely attractive drinking.
- 33 **FEDELE ROSE ORGANIC**  
*Italy. £27*  
A highly characterful, bright rose, with tons of fresh red berry fruit flavours - lively and vibrant.



## RED WINES

- 34 **BEYOND THE RIVER SHIRAZ**  
*Australia. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26*  
This Shiraz is smooth and full-bodied with ripe black fruit flavours. Soft and easy drinking.
- 35 **LOS PASTOS CABERNET SAUVIGNON**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26*  
Smooth and easy drinking and packed with ripe blackcurrant flavour with a warming peppery finish. Aromas of blackberry, black cherry and plums, hints of vanilla with smooth rounded tannins.
- 36 **LOS PASTOS MERLOT**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £26*  
Ideal for anyday casual drinking, it is a soft and fruity merlot with plenty of succulent berry and damson flavours. Also a pleasing hint of cinnamon spice typical of this user-friendly grape variety.
- 37 **MONTEVISTA CARMENERE**  
*Argentina. 175ml £7.25 250ml £9.25 Bottle £28*  
Fresh blueberry fruit with a serious savoury character and touch of spice on the finish.
- 38 **PROGRESIVO MALBEC**  
*Argentina. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
A well structured wine with plums and violets on the nose. The palate is clean with a range of fruit flavours and a good finish.
- 39 **ALTO RIOJA CRIANZA**  
*Spain. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Carefully vinified this vegan wine is made with a minimal intervention approach. 30% of the wine spends six months in French and American oak resulting in a well balanced wine with red fruits and a hint of vanilla.
- 40 **PAINTED WOLF PINOTAGE**  
*South Africa. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Medium to full bodied with bright red and black summer berries, savoury spice, and toasty wood flavours - leading to a nicely poised finish.
- 41 **NEROPASSO ROSSO**  
*Italy. £32*  
After meticulous work in the vineyard to ensure even ripening, whole bunches are harvested by hand undergoing strict selection to allow a steady drying process before crushing and fermentation. The juice of the dried grapes gives the wine so much concentration and complexity. Spicy, velvet textured wine, with indulgent dried fruit and smooth tannin.
- 42 **U'PASSIMIENTO**  
*Italy. £32*  
Made from partially dried grapes, this wine has bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. The palate is warm and full-bodied with sweet fruit, harmonious acidity, and smooth and elegant tannins.
- 43 **QUARA SPECIAL SELECTION CABERNET SAUVIGNON**  
*Argentina. £32*  
Blackcurrant and black plums on the nose supported by perfumed herbal aromatics; full bodied on the palate with firm tannins and bright acidity, toastier oak characters start to show alongside the green pepper, capsicum and cassis flavours. A big, rich and intense Cabernet.
- 44 **SANTA ALBA PINOT NOIR**  
*Chile. £32*  
Cherries, wild berries and a note of cinnamon laced smoke all appear on the alluring and inviting nose of this Pinot Noir. The palate is elegant and has just a touch of weight, fine smoky tannins, dark cherries with a hint of chocolate and subtle vanilla can all be found in this superbly crafted wine.
- 45 **PARINI MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO**  
*Italy. £35*  
Full-bodied red wine from Montepulciano grapes grown in the Abruzzo region. Deep color with raspberry notes, robust flavor, slightly tannic palate balanced with a smooth finish.
- 46 **LOS HAROLDOS MALBEC**  
*Argentina. £39*  
With over 70 years of winemaking experience, Bodega Los Haroldos's flagship Roble wine shows Malbec at its best. It's intensely fruity, with smoky and chocolate notes, all underpinned with elegant tannins and subtle acidity.
- 47 **JULIENAS LES MOUILLES BEUAJOLAIS**  
*France. £60*  
Currently in its prime, this wine has a ripe, black-fruit nose with a succulent, softly-textured palate, with a touch of spice and refreshing, acidity.
- 48 **LES COTEAUX COTES DU RHONE**  
*France. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Immediately impressive, this wine reveals its class from the start. Brambly fruit underpinned by subtle oaky nuances, lovely sweet spice - warm star anise with a touch of cinnamon.
- 49 **PORTIA ROBLE RIBERA DEL DUERO**  
*Spain. £42*  
Clean, bright, well covered, cherry, purple flashes. Nose: intense, dark fruit, blackberry and wood. Mouth: good structure, round tannins, good acidity and a good wood finish.
- 50 **LITTLE BEAUTY PINOT NOIR**  
*New Zealand. £70*  
Described as "the friend we all want at our table. Gorgeous company." Syrupy texture, nice weight, integrated. Smoky barrel ferment characters of peat, baked cherry pie, as well as luscious boysenberry and ripe blackberry.
